Defense Information Systems Agency Awards ENCORE II IT Support and Services Contract to Booz Allen Hamilton

McLean, VA — Booz Allen Hamilton today announced it has been awarded a contract under ENCORE II, a \$12.2 billion indefinite-delivery/indefinite-quantity (IDIQ) contracting vehicle that provides information technology (IT) support and services to the Military Services, Department of Defense and other agencies of the federal government.
