## Booz Allen Hamilton Purchases Healthcare Unit of Genova Technologies

*Baltimore, Maryland-based Unit Provides IT Solutions for Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services*

MCLEAN, Va.--(BUSINESS WIRE)-- Booz Allen Hamilton today announced that it has purchased the Baltimore, Md.-based healthcare unit of Genova Technologies, a move that represents the firm's commitment to further support the transformational efforts of the U.S. government's Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS).
